PE KIT

Children must have a change of clothing for PE. All children must wear either white or blue T-shirt or blue St Peter's T-Shirt and black or blue tracksuit bottoms and shorts for gymnastics, plus socks, trainers / plimsolls during PE lessons. The PE kit must be brought to school in the PE bag.

Younger children may wish to keep their PE kits at school and take them home during half term to wash them and the older children may want it washed once a fortnight.
